In our 46 years of collecting and preserving Middlebury's history, the historical society's holdings have increased greatly. Families have entrusted to us invaluable artifacts which reflect our town's heritage. We have tried to assure that these treasures will be safely preserved for future generations, and would like to expand our archival storage capabilities.

We are embarking on an exploratory program that will assess our current archive capabilities, and provide estimates for future needs, including the possibility of construction of climate-controlled areas in our building. We will be consulting with Connecticut agencies for assistance and grants for any prospective projects, and will need funds to have consultants provide expertise on how best to accomplish this.
